ROCKY RUN HOMEWORK POLICY

Rocky Run teachers believe:

- 1. The purpose of homework is for practice, review or enrichment.
- 2. Homework should be useful, relevant and meaningful.
- 3. Homework is a necessary part of learning.

As a result of these beliefs, teachers will:

- 1. Assign approximately 15 minutes of homework per subject per school night. Students taking high school level courses can anticipate 15 to 30 minutes of homework each school night. (This does not include work on long-term projects.)
- 2. Assign no more than two projects per quarter per subject or eight over the course of the school year. Some projects may be extended into two quarters.
- 3. Not assign homework over holidays or long breaks.
- Provide students access to enrichment activities to extend their learning.
