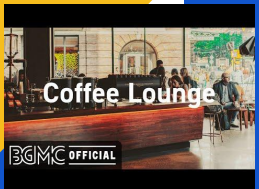

## ✓ Academic Advising Presentations

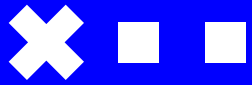
Student Services sent links to our Academic Advising Presentation before Winter Break. We then followed up with a live Q&A session with all our main feeder ES.

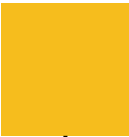

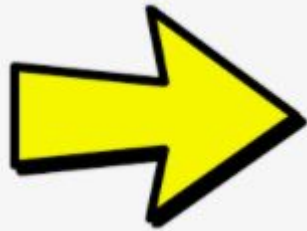
# Asynchronous Curriculum Night Google Slides

This year, all our curriculum presentations are online! You will be able to view the Curriculum Presentation asynchronously and watch videos from each department at our school.

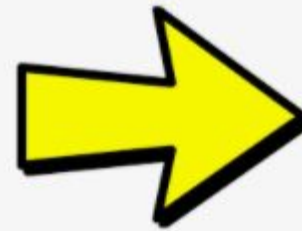


# Next Steps...

# After-School Programs

- Program starts in mid-September and clubs meet 5 days per week
- Most clubs are open enrollment so students are welcome to join at any time throughout the year. Most are free and open to both 7th and 8th graders.
