

RRMS Rock Your Summer Bingo

Have a great summer by playing Bingo!

Each square on the Bingo board is a book to read or a reading activity to complete. Shade in each square as you go to make your Bingos. Each Bingo is 5 squares in a vertical, horizontal, or diagonal direction.

Things to Know:

- Playing Bingo is optional, but **all students should read one book of choice this summer.**
- Expect a future English assignment related to your book.

Prizes:

- If you play Bingo, return this form to your English teacher. **Proof of activities is required for all prize raffle entries.** Use the back of this page or a separate paper to write down what you did, created, or read. Keep it simple and have fun!
- Shade in **one** bingo on the board for entry in the small prize raffle.
- Shade in **more than one** bingo for entry in the medium prize raffle.
- Shade in **the entire card** for entry in the large prize raffle.
- Raffles will take place in September.

Talk to an adult about a book you read.	Create a music playlist for your book.	Read to someone older than you.	Follow directions to make something.	Read in a comfy or unusual spot.
Read a graphic novel or manga.	Read for more than 30 minutes.	Turn on the captions for a TV show or a movie. Read as you watch!	Re-read a book you have read before.	Find some jokes online and tell them to a friend or family member.
