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AMC 8	<p>The after-school program will be hosting the AMC 8 competition virtually this year. The test will take place in January. The AMC 8 is a 25-question, 40-minute, multiple choice examination in middle school mathematics designed to promote the development of problem-solving skills. The AMC 8 provides an opportunity for middle school students to develop positive attitudes towards analytical thinking and mathematics that can assist in future careers. Students apply classroom skills to unique problem-solving challenges in a low-stress and friendly environment. Since participants will be taking virtually at home, a parent/guardian or other responsible adult must be available to proctor. More information about the test window and sign-up form will be available by early December. Spaces will be limited in this activity and participants will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.
