Rocky Run's After-School Program

IMPORTANT PROGRAM DATES

- Week of September 11 Preliminary club info and schedule posted on After-School Group on Schoology
- September 11 First day of late buses (teacher assistance and cross country only)
- Week of September 18 Clubs and activities begin
- May 23 Last day of after-school activities and late buses
- The After-School Program will not meet on student holidays, early release days, or during inclement weather cancellations. The program will also not meet on the following dates: September 22, October 6, October 31, November 20-21, December 15, January 12, January 24, February 16, March 22, May 24.

LATE BUS INFORMATION

- Late buses are provided on Mondays, Tuesdays*, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. Parent pick-up is required for Friday activities.
 *funded by Middle School After-School ESSER Grant
- Late buses will depart at *approximately* 4:30-5:00 pm. *Times are subject to change*.
- Late bus runs differ from the morning and afternoon runs. There are fewer buses and stops. Late bus runs will be available in late August and will be posted in Schoology.

AFTER-SCHOOL SPECIFICS

- The After-School Program is divided up into three sessions. Students are not permitted to leave school grounds before or between sessions and then return to school.
 - End of Day Transition: 2:15-2:30
 - Session 1: 2:30-3:15 (primarily academics, homework, some clubs/activities)
 - Session 2: 3:20-4:05 (clubs/activities, homework)
 - Session 3: 4:10-4:45 (intramurals, homework, socializing, dismissal)
- There is no fee for the after-school program (some clubs will require a fee due to activity registration costs).
- Most clubs are open enrollment and do not require a pre-registration. Some may require an application, audition, test to be selected. *Pay attention to announcements on Schoology so you don't miss these dates!*
- All students are required to sign into the after-school attendance program at the start of each session.
- Discuss your child's after-school plans every morning to prevent any confusion in the afternoon.
- Students should make arrangements <u>before the end of the school day</u> to stay after with a specific teacher. This will ensure that the teacher will be available.
- If you are picking your child up during a club session, you must come into the main office to sign him/her out. If you are picking up during transition times, you can meet him/her at Kiss-n-Ride. All parent pick-ups must take place no later than 4:30 pm.
- The front driveway must remain open for buses at all times.
- Encourage your child to get involved in as many activities as possible. After-school is a great time to get extra academic help and/or enrichment, make new friends, complete homework, etc.
- Every student must return the After-School Registration google form, which is included in the required forms for the school year.

ACTIVITY SCHEDULE

- Our first weekly schedule will be posted during the week of September 4.
- Weekly activity lists will be posted on Rocky Run's website in the Activities section, on Schoology, and in Rocky Run's weekly News You Choose email.
- Activities are added as the year progresses. Be sure to check back periodically for updates!
