<p>US History Ms. Brown</p>	<p>On Blackboard you will find a Parents' Tab, which answers a number of FAQ's that I have received from parents in the past.</p> <p>The FAQ's include information about grading policies and why I predominantly use Google Classroom for US History.</p> <p>We do take tests through Horizon and Blackboard platforms during the school year, but these are resources that are available to students only.</p>	<p>All graded assignments will be given through Google Classroom (Classwork Tab).</p> <p>As we move through a unit in History, I post all readings and slideshow presentations that were used in class to Google Classroom so students have those materials available to review from.</p> <p>All handouts for each unit are also posted in Google Classroom (packet format) in case students lose any handouts.</p> <p>I will post announcements for US History in Classroom.</p>	<p>Students receive packets at the beginning of each unit, with all of their handouts in one place. These handouts stay in a binder that stays in class. Students do not have to bring packets home each day since all homework is in Google Classroom.</p> <p>I very rarely assign work from the packet as homework (if I do it's because students were not using time in class like they should have).</p>	<p>All assignments (with the exception of in-class tests and quizzes) are turned in through Google Classroom. This includes homework, classwork, and projects.</p>

<p>English 7 Ms. Wetzel Ms. Slevin</p>	<p>On FCPS 24/7, under the Syllabus tab, parents can find the course syllabus, core texts list, and answers to FAQs.</p> <p>Some assessments are accessed through FCPS 24/7--eCart Tab--Horizon, but these are available through the student portal only.</p>	<p>Many course materials and assignments, along with lists of upcoming due dates are posted in Google Classroom.</p>	<p>Students should have a binder or accordion file with five tabbed dividers labeled: Reading, Writing, Vocabulary, Keepers, & In Progress</p> <p>Some assignments are completed on paper, and will be given out and worked on in class. These assignments and class handouts should be kept in the student's binder/file and brought to class each day.</p> <p>Vocabulary books/packets should be kept with/in the binder and brought to class each day during the two-week period the class is working on a vocabulary unit.</p>	<p>Google Classroom is the main platform for online work. Usually Google Class assignments are turned in electronically in Google Classroom. Exceptions will be clearly noted in the instructions for the assignment.</p> <p>Some online work will also be assigned in No Red Ink, Padlet, Newsela, and NoodleTools and should be completed within those platforms.</p> <p>Vocabulary homework will be completed in the book/packet and should be brought to class on the due date.</p> <p>Assignments on paper should be handed in to the teacher in class. They should not be turned in electronically.</p>
