Upcoming Topics for the Quarter

In Civics, we will focus on the Political Process for Third Quarter. There will be an Election Simulation in which the students will elect a class president for the Civics class period.

Science-In the third quarter we're focusing on "Changes in Matter." Your child will uncover the mysteries of how matter can transform and change state, a key aspect of chemistry. Here are the topics we'll be exploring: Thermal Energy Transfer, Chemical Reactions, Bonding, Law of Conservation, Acids and Bases

In English, third quarter brings the thematic topics of 'truth and change'. Students will explore the question, 'how do our stories express our truth?' as they take ownership of their learning in preparation for high school. Students will learn about how justice and truth make change through various texts they will annotate and discuss starting with book clubs. The summative this quarter is a detailed, persuasive outline.
