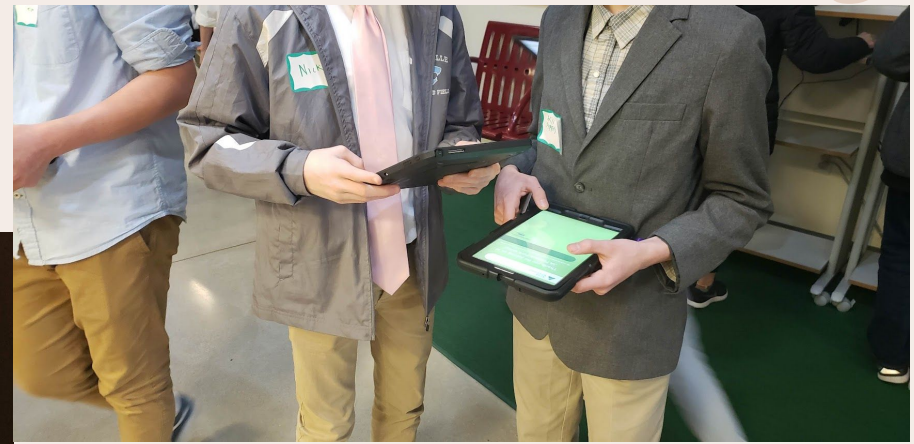
What?: To be a chaperone for our team's field trip to Finance Park
